

Robert F. Kennedy Mask Policy 22-23 Revised

Effective August 4, 2022 all students, employees, and visitors will have the option to wear masks while inside Robert F. Kennedy Charter School buildings, whether they are vaccinated or not. This includes all school buildings, classrooms, and offices. Additionally, masks will not be required when riding in school vehicles.

- While students are expected to provide their own masks, disposable masks will be made available for students who choose to continue to wear a mask.
- Disposable masks will also be provided for anyone that needs a mask while on any RFK property.
- Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 will need to isolate for 5 days after the date of their first positive test was collected. Vigilant mask wearing for 5 days after the isolation period is also required (days 6–10).
- RFK will continue to follow the CDC guidelines on mask wearing and county spread. It is important to know that changes to the transmission level in Bernalillo County and surrounding counties could result in RFK Mask Mandate being reestablished.
